Seasoned Ginger Shrimp \$ 13.95

*Jumbo shrimp wok fried with ginger and onions.

Chicken Oriental \$ 9.25

Breast of chicken, deep fried, sliced and garnished with oriental fruits in Sweet & Sour Sauce.

Butterfly Shrimp (8) \$ 12.95

Jumbo shrimps split open, pressed with bacon and dipped in egg before grilling. Served with a spicy sauce and on a bed of fried onions.

Stir Fried Shrimp & Scallops with Mixed Vegetables \$ 14.25

Fresh sea scallops and shrimp stir fried, then cooked with fresh mixed Chinese vegetables.

Korean Shrimp (8) \$ 13.45
